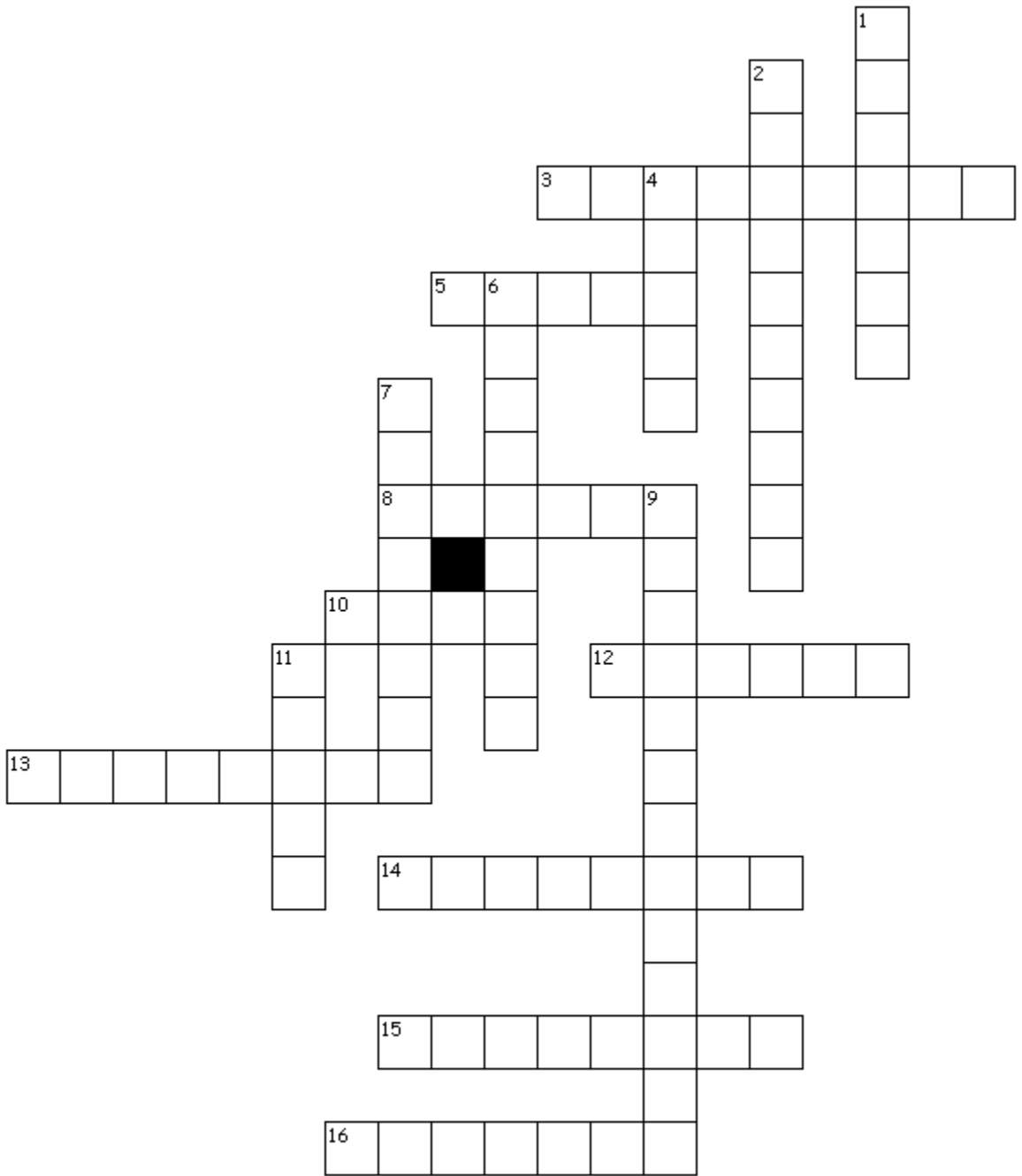

8. Knee-high footwear fashioned out of tanned hide for soles

13. Ankle-high footwear fashioned out of tanned hide for soles
14. A compress applied to a flesh wound
15. A boat construction style.
16. A heavy, flat, round bread made of flour, usually unleavened

1. Rawhide soaked in resin.
2. Being the first of its kind in a region; a first person.
4. A traditional sacred ceremony performed within a Sweat Lodge
6. Sweet and crunchy snack made when the stomach cape of a moose is rendered to remove fat and then dried.
7. Mixture of dried lean meat and rendered fat, along with berries for flavouring.
9. A type of tobacco, given as an offering or used in spiritual rituals.
11. A vegetable substance secreted by a tree, also known as tree gum or sap.
